### DR. BRITTANY LASCH

Featured Trombone Soloist

A winner of the S&R Foundation Washington Award, trombonist Brittany Lasch has appeared as a soloist with ensembles such as the U.S. Army Band "Pershing's Own," the Rodney Marsalis

Philadelphia Big Brass and with orchestras nationwide, including the St. Louis Symphony, Detroit Symphony, Nashville Symphony, The Florida Orchestra, Indianapolis Symphony, Toledo Symphony Orchestra, Rhode Island Philharmonic, the Oregon Bach Festival Orchestra, the Vermont Symphony, Albany Symphony, and the New World Symphony. Dr. Lasch is the newly appointed Assistant Professor of Trombone at the Jacobs School of Music at Indiana University. She also performs as Principal Trombone of the Detroit Opera Orchestra at the Detroit Opera House.

Dr. Lasch has been a featured guest artist at numerous festivals including the International Trombone Festival, the International Women's Brass Conference, and the American Trombone Workshop. A prizewinner in numerous competitions, Dr. Lasch received the coveted John Clark Award upon graduation from the Manhattan School of Music for outstanding accomplishment in Brass Performance. She was also a winner of Astral Artist's National Auditions as well as the winner of the National Collegiate Solo Competition hosted by the U.S. Army Band and the Eisenberg-Fried Brass Concerto Competition at the Manhattan School of Music. Her trombone quartet won the 2017 ITA's Quartet Competition. In 2018, Brittany was awarded 2nd place in The American Prize solo instrumentalist competition.

A native of Park Ridge, Illinois, Dr. Lasch earned her DMA degree from Boston University, where she received the Brass Department Award. She also holds a Master of Music degree from Yale School of Music, and she has served as faculty at Bowling Green State University and the Boston University Tanglewood Institute. Dr. Lasch is an Edwards Trombone Performing Artist.

The Brass Band of Central Illinois was formed in 2004 to actively promote the cultural awareness and tradition of brass bands. It also provides a musical outlet for brass players who enjoy the unique sound and instrumentation of brass band music.

Based in Bloomington as a non-profit organization, the band is dedicated to providing concerts that are both entertaining and educational. Performing a wide variety of music, the band offers indoor concerts in May and December, as well as outdoor concerts every summer. All of our concerts are free and fully accessible to the public, with no admission fee or ticket required.

Our membership is composed of volunteer musicians from all walks of life including current and retired band directors, employees of State Farm Insurance, an anesthesiologist, a civil engineer, a Dept. of Homeland Security employee, and a former railroad engineer. Many of our members reside in Bloomington/Normal, but others travel from Peoria, LaSalle, El Paso, Urbana, Monticello, Gridley, Morton and Pontiac in order to rehearse and perform with the band.



Since 2007, Dr. Sharon Huff has been the Music Director and conductor of the band. Dr. Huff is a retired music professor and former public school music teacher who previously taught at Millikin University, Illinois State University, St. Norbert College, and Unit 5 Schools in Normal, IL. Dr. Huff is a native of Bloomington/Normal, and she holds a B.M.E. summa cum laude from ISU and a M.M. and D.M.A. from the University of Illinois.
