## APPLICATION GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIPS & AWARDS FALL 2012-SPRING 2013

Illinois State University School of Art scholarships are awarded primarily on the basis of artistic talent and potential. The School of Art offers several scholarships and awards ranging from \$200 to full 12-hour tuition waivers. These scholarships are available for Art majors only. Students pursuing a degree in any art sequence, graduate or undergraduate, are encouraged to apply.

Each student applying for scholarships will be required to submit a **digital** portfolio by **4:00 pm on Friday, March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2012** to the Art office CVA 119.

If application is with scholarly writing rather than a portfolio, examples of writing are due by **4:00 pm on Friday, March 9<sup>th</sup>, 2012** to the Art office CVA 119.

### **Awards will be announced at the Student Annual opening on Tuesday, April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2012.** GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIP PORTFOLIO

1. Applicants are asked to submit their work on a CD by 4 pm:

For submitting **digital** portfolios:

Portfolios should be limited to 10-15 works and comprised of ISU School of Art work **ONLY**. Art videos are acceptable, but videos documenting 2-D art and small 3-D works are not. Digital Portfolios should have all images placed in a single folder, and **SHOULD NOT** open in Photoshop.

Submit artwork in a professional manner. In general, make your work as accessible for the reviewers as you can **and include on a sheet of paper a list with the title/description, medium, and size of each artwork in the portfolio; identify each artwork on the list with the same number as the JPEG filename. Also include a brief artist statement, no longer than one page.**

Students submitting examples of scholarly, critical or analytical writing must submit two to four papers, typed in standard form. To be considered for a scholarship or award based on writing, the student's GPA will be considered.

2. The School of Art and the Scholarship Committee are not responsible for work damaged or lost. Student should be prompt in picking up materials.
3. Works will be available for pick-up after 9 am Friday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> and must be picked up before 4:00 pm Friday, March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2012.
