Daniel Adam Maltz is a fortepianist based in Vienna, Austria. He specializes in *Wiener Klassik* — Viennese Classicism — especially the works of Haydn, Mozart, and Beethoven performed on the Viennese fortepianos of their time.

He is in demand worldwide with 50+ tour dates per year as a sought- after soloist, Lieder accompanist, and clinician. Daniel also hosts Classical Cake, the podcast about Viennese classical music and culture.
